The Civil War Round Table of Chicago will be touring the fields of Middle Tennessee for its 65th Annual Tour, April 29 through May 3, 2015. Our base hotel is the Holiday Inn Opryland/Airport 2200 Elm Hill Pike, Nashville, TN 37214. Check in is Wednesday, April 29, 2015 and dinner is on your own. As always, breakfasts will be on your own; there will be a buffet each morning in the hotel restaurant.

Our eminently-qualified tour guides will be **Col. Ed Bearss and Stones River Park Ranger - Jim Lewis**. We will utilize two buses; refreshments will be available. Buses begin boarding at 7:30 a.m. and depart promptly at 8:00 a.m.

Day One, Thursday, April 30, 2015

Forts Heiman, Henry, Donelson and Defiance, possibly other sites if time allows.

Lunch: Buffet catered by Dover Grille at the Stewart County Visitors Center in Dover.

Dinner with cash bar will be at the base hotel; our speaker will be **Jim Lewis**, Stones River Park Ranger.

Day Two, Friday, May 1, 2015,

Various sites including Stones River National Battlefield, Oaklands Historic House (no tour), and the Rutherford County Courthouse, possibly other sites if time allows

Lunch: the Slick Pig BBQ in Murfreesboro

Dinner with cash bar will be at the base hotel; our speaker will be **Col Ed Bearss**.

Day Three, Saturday, May 2, 2014

Columbia, Spring Hill, Rippavilla, and Franklin--Winstead Hill, Carter House (tour) and Carnton Plantation (tour) - possibly other sites if time allows

Lunch: Box lunch by Panera at Pinkerton Park next to Fort Granger

Note: We will not be returning to the hotel before Fun Night Begins

Fun Night: the Eastern Flank Battlefield Event Pavilion in Franklin catered by Loveless Event Catering.

We will board the buses at the end of the event to return to the hotel

Day Four, Sunday, May 4, 2014

Our final day of the tour: Nashville including Fort Negley, Battery Granberry and Shy's Hill.

As is our custom, a **box lunch** will be provided at the hotel, after which participants will disperse and head for home. The Holiday Inn will provide transportation free of charge back to the airport.
